EXPANDED CLINICAL CARE

HCI operates at three community clinics located in South Jordan, Farmington, and Sugar House. Considering current clinical case loads and projected population growth, continued expansion of clinical space is needed.



MOBILE SCREENING FOR UNDERSERVED POPULATIONS

Our cancer screening bus brings the latest screening technology to urban and rural residents, including those who live in distant areas. In the first six months of operation, more than 1,000 women received mammograms—many for the first time. Additional bus services include skin cancer screenings and education on cancer prevention.



QUALITY CARE IN HOMES

Huntsman at Home (H@H) provides cancer care for patients who live far from HCI. It delivers many aspects of care in a patient's own home as an alternative to hospital visits. Recently, H@H was expanded to four rural Utah counties, but more expansion is needed.
