




How Your Donation Helps

The team also includes researchers focusing on pediatric cancer genomics and long-term outcomes.

With the youngest population in the United States, having this new center in Utah will lead to advances in critical research areas like childhood cancer predisposition, survivorship, and therapeutic efficacy and resistance. It will address unmet medical needs for young people across the region and shape the future of cancer care.

Your contribution will advance cancer research and treatment for people like Olivia, who was 7 years old when she was diagnosed with Wilms Tumor stage four kidney cancer. The cancer, which targets children, spread to her lungs and main arteries. Olivia received radiation at HCI, then doctors removed one of her kidneys. Today, she is a PCH nurse and cancer free. "I cannot thank HCI enough," Olivia says. "They really were my saving grace and they are why I am a survivor."
