CUSTOMIZING YOUR FUNDRAISING PAGE

Your personal fundraising page is your number one tool for collecting donations! This is where people go to donate and support your Huntsman Cancer Foundation SportsFest fundraising goal. Use it to tell your community why you're participating and how much their contribution means to you. Your page will track your fundraising progress and highlight your donors and their donations as well!

VIRTUAL PARTICIPANTS! Even though you can't be at the event in person, you can still make a huge impact. Use your personal fundraising webpage to stay connected and drive your efforts. Share your story, engage with supporters, and boost donations by keeping everyone updated with your progress.



TO CUSTOMIZE YOUR PAGE AND STORY:

Log into your Participant Dashboard. You can access this by visiting HuntsmanSportsFest.com and clicking "LOGIN" on the top right corner of the page. Once logged in, click "Personalize Page" on the left-hand side to get going!

UPDATE YOUR FUNDRAISING GOAL

- Your goal will be automatically set to a suggested goal, but it is adjustable. We encourage you to dream big! Remember, every donation makes an impact with 100% benefiting the mission of Huntsman Cancer Institute.
- HOW TO UPDATE: On the left side of your page, click the pencil icon next to "Fundraising Goal."

UPLOAD A PROFILE PHOTO AND COVER PHOTO

- Your community is here to support you, and they'll love to see your smiling face! This is a great place to also include a photo of your team, company, or the person or reason you are fundraising. Remember: a picture is worth a thousand words!
- HOW TO UPDATE: Click the camera icon in the top right corner of your cover photo or in your square profile picture.

SHARE YOUR PAGE

- It's time! Now that you've customized your story, it's time to share your personal fundraising page. On your fundraising page, copy the URL and share it on your social media, via text message, or in an email. Ask people to donate toward your goal to help advance and propel life-changing cancer research and programs for children and adults at Huntsman Cancer Institute.



TELLING YOUR SPORTSFEST STORY

Your “why” is the #1 reason your community will support you! Fundraising and making a difference starts when you share why you SportsFest and ask people to support and join you. Jotting down your answers to a few key questions can help you share, and ask, with confidence!

First things first...why are you participating in Huntsman Cancer Foundation SportsFest?

Past participants have shared reasons including that they joined the event to help advance the mission of Huntsman Cancer Institute in honor or memory of a loved one, or that it's a good way to support a cause that makes an impact in the Mountain West region and across the world! Those who have experienced cancer may appreciate SportsFest as a way to partner with and support the staff at Huntsman Cancer Institute to fuel new breakthroughs, thank their care team by fundraising for their area of work, or give friends and family a way to take action and show their support.

Great! Next up: how are you participating this year?

Are you riding your bike, walking, running, or taking on quest, a team-based scavenger hunt? Is this distance or activity a new athletic challenge or milestone for you or your team? This is a nice detail to share with potential donors!

Let's talk about what Huntsman Cancer Foundation SportsFest is!

SportsFest is a day dedicated to making an impact by participating in and fundraising via different events. These include a bike ride (with distances ranging from 16 miles to 140 miles), a 1K Stroll, a Kids Fun K, a 5K walk/run, a 10K trail walk/run, a scavenger hunt, or a virtual option. Every pedal stroke and step helps fuel research and hope at Huntsman Cancer Institute!

TOP FUNDRAISING TIPS

When you fundraise as a SportFester, you are part of a strong community that is working to eradicate cancer. Together, we are doing amazing things! Below are our top five tips to help you start raising money for cancer research to help advance treatments and improve the lives of those affected by cancer.

1 Make a List

Make a list of potential donors and include everyone you know. Send each one a personal note asking for a donation. Most are willing to donate, so don't assume the answer is no. You can even make a donation yourself and ask others to match it.

2 Share Your Personal Experience

Sharing your personal connection to cancer can make it easier to inspire others to take action. Write your story on your personal fundraising webpage then share the link via email, text, or on social media asking for donations to the cause. When you share your "why," you will be surprised how many people are willing to help.

FUN FACT: We've done all the work for you! Check out our [fundraising tools and resources](#) to take the guesswork out of ways to fundraise. We have social media templates, graphics, fundraising tips, videos, and more!

3 Ask, Ask, Ask!

Did you know that it often takes potential donors up to three asks to give? Never stop asking. Cancer affects us all and most people are happy to donate, even in harder economic times. Need help figuring out how to ask? We have created various templates, prewritten emails, and more to help you on your fundraising journey.

4 Spread the Word

Social media is a fun and easy way to turn friends, family, colleagues, and neighbors into donors. Think big and use your social media outlets to tap into a new network of people beyond your immediate contacts. You might be surprised by the number of donations you can get just by sharing your personal fundraising webpage. 5 Matching Gifts

Some employers will gladly match donor gifts, doubling their donation. Check out the [Matching Gifts page](#) on our website for more information on how to make matching gifts work for you.

QUICK TIP: When using Facebook to fundraise, make sure to use your SportsFest personal fundraising page URL via a post or message rather than creating a Facebook fundraiser. By using your personal fundraising page URL, donors can contribute directly to your fundraising goal, receive an emailed receipt for their donation, and you will be able to view that a donation was made.

DON'T FORGET—it's always a great idea to thank your donors! Being thanked makes them feel great about the impact they're making, and many will give again.

Here are a few ideas to help keep the donations rolling in.

1 Don't Stop

WAYS TO DONATE

ONLINE DONATIONS

The easiest and best way for your supporters to give is online, through your personal fundraising page. Plus, donations made online appear on your page immediately! There are two ways for your donors to give online:

- Go to HuntsmanSportsFest.com, click “DONATE” on the top right of the navigation bar, search your name, and voila! They can click on your page right here in the search results.
- If you’ve sent them your direct link to your personal fundraising page, they can donate right then and there!

CHECKS

If your donor would like to write a check, please ask them to:

- Include the participant’s full name or team’s name on the memo line or include it with the check, so our team knows how to designate the gift.

DONATION RECEIPTS & ACKNOWLEDGMENTS

- Donations to SportsFest are 100% tax-deductible.
- Donors who make an online gift will automatically receive a receipt and tax acknowledgment via email. You, as the participant, will also receive an email letting you know that a donation has been made to your fundraising page.
- Donors who make an offline gift (via check, donor advised fund, etc.) will receive a printed acknowledgment in the mail.

OTHER WAYS TO GIVE

DONATE FROM A DONOR-ADVISED FUND (DAF)

For donors who have a DAF, initiating a grant recommendation is easy!

1. The donor will need to contact the company that runs their DAF.
2. They will need to recommend a donation to Huntsman Cancer Foundation.
3. Please ask them to include the event name (Huntsman Cancer Foundation SportsFest) and your name with the donation so we can easily apply it to your page when it arrives.

** Note: DAF donations may take several weeks to arrive after initiation.*

TRANSFER STOCK, BONDS, OR MUTUAL FUNDS

To transfer stock, bonds, or mutual funds, please email the Huntsman Cancer Foundation events team directly at events@huntsmanfoundation.org for assistance.

IMPORTANT!

When mailing a check or receiving a donation, please be sure to indicate that the donation is for SportsFest, and include the participant or team name that the donation is intended to support. Many gifts come through with little to no information, and without it, there is no way for us to connect the donation back to you!

If you know about an expected gift coming in via check or one of the other listed options, please email us at events@huntsmanfoundation.org so we can help you look for it and apply it to your fundraising page once it arrives.

MATCHING GIFTS

MAXIMIZING MATCHING GIFTS

Did you know that over 26 million individuals work for companies with matching gift programs? Corporate matching gifts are a great way to maximize a donation and harness the generosity of companies and employers for a great cause!

Here are three important things you and your donors can do to help matching gifts arrive correctly and in a timely manner:

1. Have yourself, or the donor, become familiar with the company's matching gift program.
2. Apply for matches as soon as possible.
3. Ask your donors to include important details about the intention of the gift when they submit their match, especially including the event name, Huntsman Cancer Foundation SportsFest, and your full name as the participant.



Only matching donations received by the fundraising deadline, June 30, 2026, will count toward earning this year's fundraising incentives.

LET'S SEE WHAT COMPANIES MATCH! Search if an employer will match a gift by using our [Matching Gift Search Tool online](#).

It is important to note that matching gifts can take several weeks or months to arrive, and Huntsman Cancer Foundation cannot control when third-party companies transfer matching gifts.
