In addition to the need for greater inpatient capacity, expanded outpatient, wellness, and survivorship support services will be offered to patients and their families.

NAMED SPACE OPPORTUNITIES:

This facility will feature details to match the décor of our existing hospital. Large, panoramic windows and ample natural light will provide an atmosphere of optimism, serenity, and healing:

- Cherry and maple-wood walls and ceilings
- Granite floors and finishes
- Inspiring artwork
- Comfortable furnishings and soothing colors

This expansion will include 48 additional inpatient rooms, a floor dedicated to the screening and treatment for breast and gynecological cancers, additional clinical space, and an expanded Wellness and Integrative Health Center. Doubling the size of our existing wellness and survivorship programs, cancer patients throughout Utah and beyond will have access to an array of therapies and services to complement their cancer treatment, enhance outcomes, and foster lifelong well-being.

Available named spaces range from \$10K to \$10M and some examples include:

- Exam room - **\$25K**
- Reception and Waiting areas - **\$250K - \$500K**
- Skybridge - **\$2M**
- Floor lobby - **\$1M - \$5M**




Clinic Waiting Room

- Specialized care for the mind, body, and spirit before, during, and after treatment
- Advanced programs for cancer screening, diagnosis, and treatment
- Expanded clinic space for breast, cervical, and ovarian cancers
- Precise diagnosis leading to the most effective treatments
- Private meeting spaces for oncologists and patients
