## Skating with the MN Wild Contest Rules

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. ALL FEDERAL, STATE, LOCAL, AND MUNICIPAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS APPLY. VOIDWHERE PROHIBITED.

### 1. Eligibility

Skating with the MN Wild ("Contest") is open to legal residents of the fifty (50) United States and District of Columbia who are at least eighteen (18) years old at the time of entry. Employees of Children's Minnesota Foundation and other companies associated with the promotion of the Contest, and their respective parents, subsidiaries, and affiliates as well as the immediate family (spouse, parent, siblings, and children) and household members of such employee are not eligible.

## 2. Sponsor

# 3. Agreement to Official Rules

Participation in the Contest constitutes entrant's full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules and the decisions of Sponsor, which are final and binding. ## 4. Contest Period

The Contest begins on October 23, 2023, at 8 a.m. and ends on November 24, 2023, at 5 p.m. Entries that are submitted before or after the Contest Period will be disqualified. Submissions will be accepted for the duration of the Contest via online or mail-in submission.

#### 5. How to Enter

Via Online: Anyone who makes a donation to any of MN Wild player's pages from the MN Wild site (https://join.childrensmn.org/give-today-support-tomorrow/minnesota-wild) will be automatically entered into the contest.

Via Mail: On a 3x5 card, handprint your full name, complete address, phone number (including area code), date of birth, and email address (optional) and mail in an envelope with proper postage affixed to: Children's Minnesota Foundation, located at 5901 Lincoln Drive, CBC-3-FOUND, Edina, MN 55436. Mail-in entries must be hand-printed and mailed in separately. All mail-in entries must be postmarked by November 24, 2023, and received by December 1, 2023.

Limit one (1) entry per person, per email address, and per household for the duration of the Contest Period, regardless of method of entry. Entries received from any person, email address, or household in excess of the stated limitation shall be void. All entries become the property of Sponsorand will not be acknowledged or returned.

#### 6. Odds

The odds of being selected depend on the number of eligible entries received.

## 7. Prize Drawing

On or about December 8, 2023, Sponsor will select potential winners in a random drawing from among all eligible entries received. Sponsor will attempt to notify the potential winner via telephone or email on or about December 8, 2023. If the potential winner cannot be

In the event that the operation, security, or administration of the Contest is impaired in any way for any reason, including, but not limited to fraud, virus, bug, worm, unauthorized human intervention or other technical problem, or in the event the Contest is unable to run as planned for any other reason as determined by Sponsor it its sole discretion, the Sponsor may, in its sole discretion, either (a) suspend the Contest to address the impairment and then resume the Contest in a manner that best conforms to the spirit of these Official Rules, or (b) terminate the Contest and, in the event of termination, award the prize at random from among the eligible entries received up to the time of impairment.
