To achieve this, we are focused on three pillars:

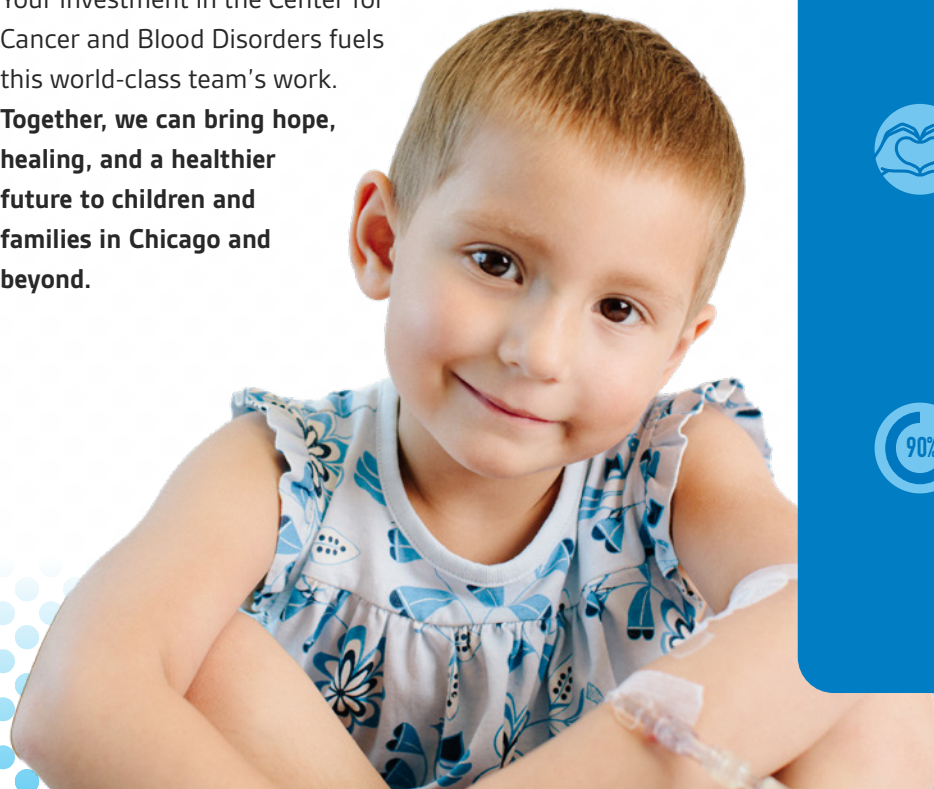
