



HOW TO GET STARTED

Connect with our local hospital advisor to learn more about the process and see what option works best for you and your school:

Join our Teen Leadership Board - (Bridges Teen Leadership Board) city-wide programs within the Chicago North shore region that includes city high schools, community teams and corporate sponsors. This route is reserved for high school students in Chicago's Northshore area.
Independent Program - This opportunity would allow you to compile your own board and create an event that is tailor-made for your school. College, University, and grades K-12 campuses are welcome to start a Dance Marathon! Your hospital advisor will provide resources from a fundraising to recruitment, to event-day logistics. You will be provided an on-line fundraising tracking page for students and leaders to directly utilize.
Affiliate Program - this opportunity would allow your students to be mentored by a collegiate Dance Marathon program forming a Dance Marathon partnership between both schools. Along with your hospital advisor, college students would help plan, mentor, and be present at your day of event to help ensure this event runs smoothly. All funds raised from your Dance Marathon would be added to the University Dance Marathon total - and celebrated as a partnership between the schools. Your school would also be invited to attend the University Celebration! This route is reserved for K-12 programs.

Once you pick how you would like to partner, you will have access to a local and national database of resources that will help you and your team create a lasting impact on Lurie Children's.
