Supporting the Heart of the Hospital

The Founders' Board of Lurie Children's has made a generous two-year \$4.5 million commitment to support Lurie Children's Heart Center and our dedicated nursing staff. Collectively, the Founders' Board has committed \$40 million to Lurie Children's campaign *for every child*, which represents the largest single commitment to the campaign.

Today, **one in 100 babies is born with congenital heart disease**. While there have been significant advancements made to help children survive heart disease, Lurie Children's remains vigilant in **ensuring kids not only survive but thrive** to lead healthy, productive lives.

With your support, the Founders' Board's commitment will change the future for children with heart disease, from groundbreaking interventions before birth to exceptional outcomes through our top-ranked heart transplant program and vital follow-up services to support the whole child and family.

This year's event will spotlight the Fetal Cardiac Intervention Program, the next frontier for The Chicago Institute for Fetal Health. Currently, very few hospitals globally offer in utero procedures to treat congenital heart disease. At Lurie Children's, **20% of patients within the Institute for Fetal Health present with a heart disorder**. Lurie Children's will establish the Midwest's first fetal cardiac intervention program to treat devastating heart conditions such as hypoplastic left heart syndrome. By repairing hearts before birth, Lurie Children's stands to dramatically improve outcomes and survival of these high-risk babies.
